Recipe of the Month Summer Salad with Corn, Strawberries & Avocado

Ingredients:

- 1 ear of corn, husks removed
- 1 long English cucumber, chopped
- 2 cups cherry tomatoes
- 1/2 an avocado, cubed
- 2 cups fresh strawberries
- 1/2 cup fresh basil, chopped
- 1/3 cup crumbled feta
- 1/2 a lemon, juice only
- 2 Tbsp olive oil
- Salt + pepper to taste

Instructions:

- 1. Steam corn in boiling water. Then cool, and slice kernels into a bowl.
- 2. Chop all other ingredients
- In a large bowl, combine all chopped ingredients, add feta, basil, oil, lemon juice, salt and pepper.
- 4. Toss to combine.
