#### Recipe of the Month Deviled Eggs

#### Ingredients

- 6 large eggs
- 3 TBSP Mayonnaise
- 1 tsp Dijon mustard
- 1 tsp apple cider vinegar
- Salt and pepper to taste
- Paprika for garnish

### Instructions:

- Bring pot of water to a boil. Reduce heat to low and place the eggs in the water.
- 2. Then increase the heat back to high and set timer for 14 minutes.
- 3. While eggs are boiling, prepare an ice water bath and set aside. After 14 minutes, remove eggs from hot water and place in ice water bath.
- 4. Once cooled completely, peel them and slice in half lengthwise. Remove yolk to a small bowl. Place eggs whites on a plate.
- 5. Mash yolks with a fork and add other ingredients. Stir until smooth.
- 6. Add portions of the egg mixture back on egg white.
- 7. Sprinkle paprika for garnish.
