Recipe of the Month Game Day Meatballs

Ingredients:

2 pounds ground beef2 eggs

3/4 C Italian breadcrumbs

3-4 TBSP diced onion

3/4 C shredded cheddar cheese

1/4 C ketchup

2-3 dashes Worcestershire sauce

1 tsp salt and pepper 12 oz BBQ sauce Fresh parsley for garnish

Instructions:

Preheat oven at 350 degrees.

Combine ground beef, eggs, breadcrumbs, onion, cheese, ketchup, Worcestershire sauce, salt, pepper in bowl.

Form 1-inch meatballs.

Place on baking rack, and bake for 20 min.

Cover meatballs with BBQ sauce and bake for additional 7 min.
