ANNUAL CHILI COOK-OFF

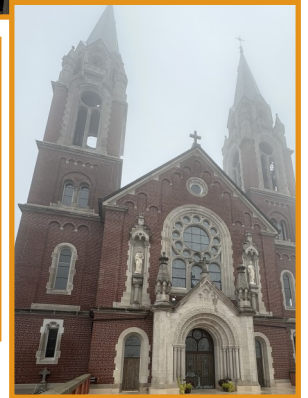


Residents, staff, and community members gathered for some good fun and great food. With eight amazing chili entries, the competition was definitely on! A big shout

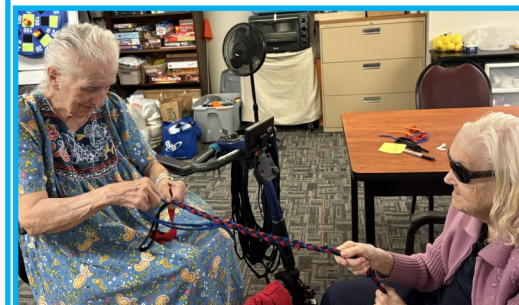


COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP WITH THE RONALD MCDONALD HOUSE

McDonald House, and in return, the house warmly welcomed them with a lovely tour. It was a wonderful experience for everyone!

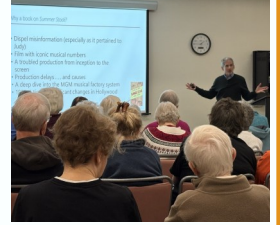


Center for Enrichment

Recipe of the Month **Fall Cranberry Salad**

Ingredients:

1/2 C cider vinegar
1/4 C fresh cranberries
1/4 C olive oil
2 tsp white sugar
1/8 tsp salt
Pinch black pepper
2 heads romaine lettuce
2 heads Belgian Endive
2 red Anjou pears
1/2 C toasted walnuts
1/2 C crumbled Gorgonzola cheese

Instructions:

Combine vinegar and cranberries in a saucepan. Cook over medium heat until soft. Remove from heat. Add olive oil, sugar, salt, pepper. Place in a blender and mix until smooth. Refrigerate.

Core and julienne one pear, core and dice the other.

Combine lettuces, diced pears, walnuts, cheese in large bowl. Drizzle with dressing.

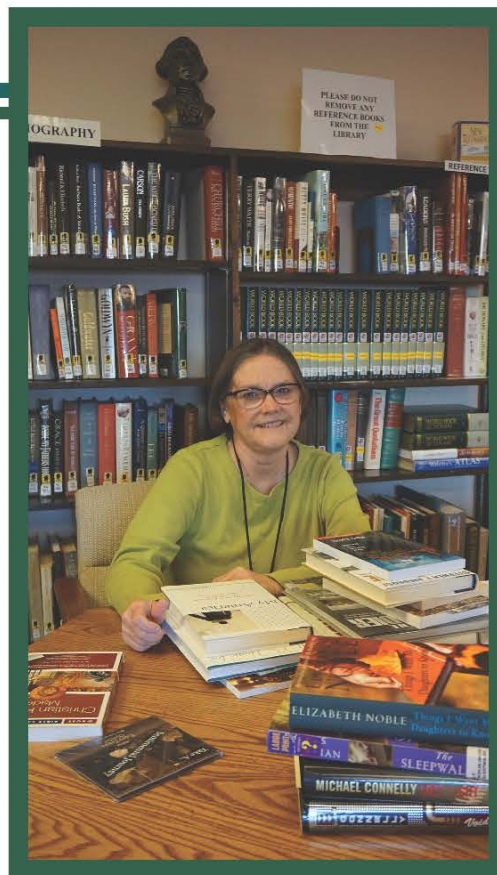

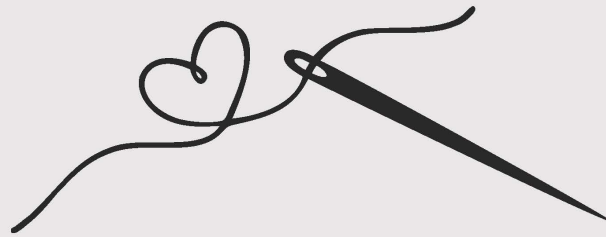
