Beginning this April, the quilt will become a central part of our newly developed Departure Ceremony. This ceremony was thoughtfully designed to honor the lives of residents who pass away while in our care, and to provide a meaningful way for our community to support one another in times of loss.

When a resident passes away, staff and community members who wish to participate will gather near the resident's room for a brief reading and prayer. Together, we will accompany the resident on their final journey through the building, singing 'Amazing Grace' as a symbol of unity, respect, and comfort. At the doorway, we pause for a final blessing as a way to say farewell and to thank family and friends for entrusting us with the care of their loved one.

During the recent blessing ceremony, residents, staff, and visitors got a close look at the quilt and met the Sisters whose hands and hearts brought it to life. Their presence served as a powerful reminder of the spiritual bonds guiding our work.

As we embrace this new tradition, we do so with the hope of offering comfort, dignity, and connection. Every life lived at Clement Manor is a gift, and through this ritual of remembrance, we honor each one and support all who grieve.
