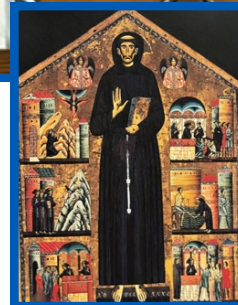


BISHOP HAINES BLESSING

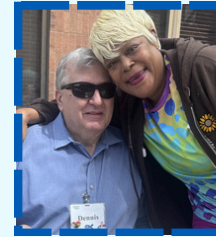
EASTER FLOWERS

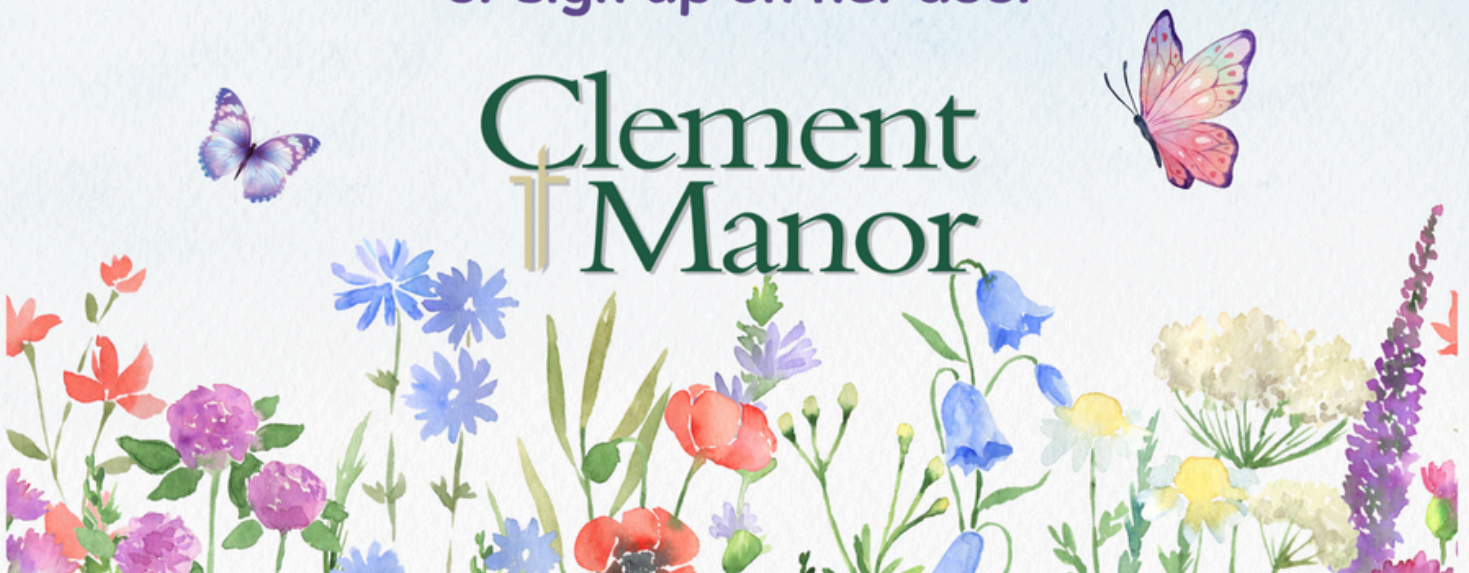
