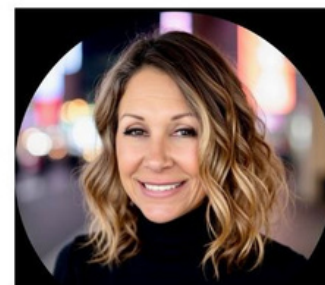

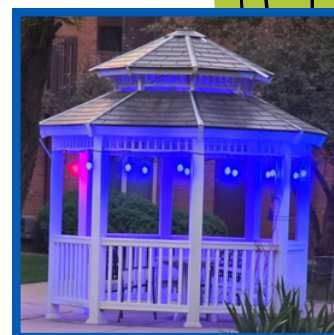
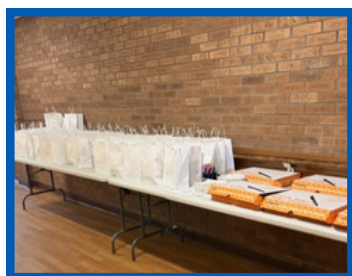

A TRIP TO THE MOTHER HOUSE

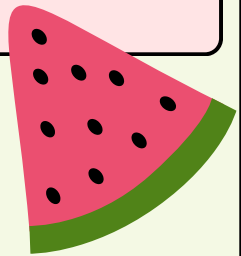
