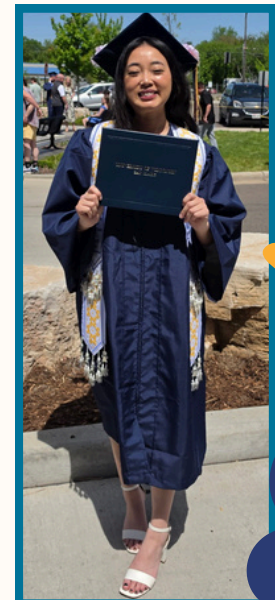
## STAFF GROWTH

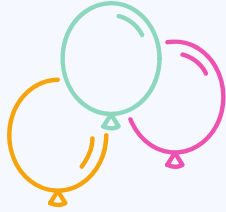

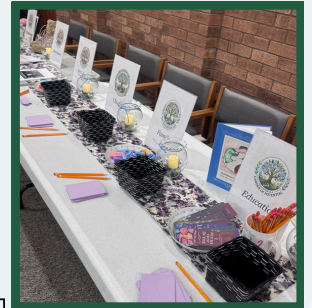
